Evensong & Concert: At 6pm on Sunday 26th April, the St. Mary’s Choir will join with the Yatton & Winscombe Chorale in leading a Choral Evensong service, and this will be followed by a short concert of items from Chorale members, culminating in the Hallelujah Chorus from Messiah sung by the combined choirs. During the afternoon that day, the **Church Tower will be open** and Cream Teas served.

Contactless Terminals: St. Mary’s now has three of these – two in church and one brought out from the Office as required. Please be reassured that any monies given to the parish through these devices is treated in exactly the same way as a cash donation at the same time & place: e.g. at Service times, the sums are treated as part of the Collections; at Saturday Coffee mornings, they are added to the cash given for the Care of St. Mary’s; at most other times in church the sums are treated as “Wallbox Donations”. The only exception is in respect of charity donations after funerals, when the Funeral Directors take the cash collected and pass it on to the chosen charity.
